All puppies must be current on their vaccinations and no puppies under 3 months of age will be allowed at the trial. No Exceptions. No puppy sales at trial site. No puppies under 3 months of age in RV's. If you have young puppies, please bring a Stud Certificate to verify age. This will be strictly enforced. You will be asked to leave and no refunds will be given.

There will be no food service available at the park. There are many fast food restaurants nearby.

REFUNDS for classes will be given ONLY in cases of accident or illness of a terrier or owner, or for bitches in season. Situations must be documented in writing. Refunds provided by mail within 14 days following the trial.

**Division A: Racing – Judge: Bud Moomau** Racing will begin promptly at <u>10:00 AM</u>. All terriers including 3-6 month puppies *must have "closed end" muzzles for racing*. (Muzzles will be available on site for purchase or loan.) No cross entering between adult and veteran classes. <u>NOTES:</u> The track will be 250-300 feet in length with 4 hurdles. For this event, hurdles will be <u>LOW</u> for <u>ALL</u> age groups. Dogs *MAY* enter both the maiden class and their regular class in racing ONLY.

<u>Thunder Tunnel Division – Judge: Emory Vaughn</u> This is a timed event with the terrier working their way through an above ground tunnel. One side of the tunnel is clear. Each terrier runs the tunnel twice and the better of the two times is the final time posted. You may pay at the gate but will be charged the post entry price. (The tie breaker will be the dogs second time.)

<u>Conformation – Judge: Connie Jones</u> Based on JRTCA breed standard. Spay/Neutered and colored terriers are welcome to enter these classes. Maiden division will include handling advice and tips from the judge. *No cross entering.* 

- Class 47 Puppies 3-6 months (open to dog & bitch pups at least 3 months old not over 6 months)
- Class 48 Puppies 6-12 months (open to dog & bitch pups over 6 months old but not exceeding 12 months)
- Class 49 Adult terrier (open to dog & bitch terriers that have reached 1 year old but not yet 6 years old)
- Class 50 Veteran terrier (open to dog & bitch terriers that have reached 6 years old but not yet 9 years old)
- Class 51 Senior terrier (open to dog & bitch terriers that are 9 years old or older)
- Class 52 Maiden Terrier (Any height, Any age over a year, in their first year of competition)

**Overall Conformation Champion & Reserve:** Open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners from puppies, adults, veterans and seniors.

# Camping

Camping is available at the trial site for \$25 per night. Most camp site have electric and water. First come, first serve. 50 amp services available so be prepared with adaptors.

# Directions To The Trial Site

From I - 85 South & North - Take I-85 north or south to Exit 17 which is the Highway 321 exit. Turn left onto 321 north. Travel two miles and you will come to the Dallas/Cherryville exit. Gaston College will be on your left. You will need to move to the far right lane, go under the bridge and take the Cherryville side of the exit. Turn right onto Hwy 279 west and follow Final Directions below.

From I - 40 West- Traveling West on I-40, take exit 126 in Hickory. Turn left at the stoplight onto McDonald Pky. Travel through all stoplights, road turns to two lanes. Follow this road until you come to the Hwy 321 entrance ramp. Take the Hwy 321 south entrance. Continue traveling south on Hwy 321 to the Dallas/Cherryville exit. Turn right at the stoplight onto Hwy 279 West and follow Final Directions below.

From I - 40 East -Traveling East on I-40, take exit 123 on the west side of Hickory to Hwy 321 south. Follow Hwy 321 south to the Dallas/Cherryville exit. Turn right at the stop sign onto Hwy 279 West and follow Final Directions below.

Final Directions - Traveling west on Hwy 279, move to left lane and travel through all stoplights and past fast food restaurants. The Gaston County Citizens Resource Center is on left. Turn left into the drive on the far side of the Center. We will have signs posted directing everyone where to go.
