******ALL TERRIERS MUST BE MUZZLED! Plastic muzzle or close-ended cloth muzzles only. No figure eight or open-ended muzzles will be allowed. COLORED BASKET AND COLORED SOFTIE MUZZLES ARE NOT ALLOWED. Black, brown, clear or white muzzles are acceptable. NO BASKERVILLE MUZZLES ALLOWED.**

CJRTC is going green. If you have submitted your trial certificates to the trial secretary in the past two years, they will be on file and you will not need to submit them again. New trial certificates should be submitted with your entries. **Please also note that go-to-ground & super earth papers for certificate classes are not included in your trial packet. They are not needed to send in for certificate purposes. Only papers will be included for Novice and Open Go-to-Ground or Super Earth participants.**

All puppies must be current on their vaccinations and no puppies under 3 months of age will be allowed at the trial. No Exceptions. No puppy sales at trial site. No puppies under 3 months of age in RV's. If you have young puppies, please bring a Stud Certificate to verify age. This will be strictly enforced. You will be asked to leave and no refunds will be given.

There will be no food service available at the park. There are many fast food restaurants nearby.

Scores from racing flats, racing hurdles and go-to-ground will be added together. 1st - 5 points, 2nd - 3 points, 3rd - 2 points and 4th - 1 point. Go little guys and girls!!!

All Go-To-Ground Participants, Please Read!

Due to excessive waits for people participating in GTG with one terrier, we are implementing a new procedure. If you choose to bring all of your terriers to GTG at one time, you may run one terrier and while you are getting your next terrier ready to go, you must let the next person in line run theirs.

Every effort will be made to start trial events on time. Dogs late to racing or conformation will be scratched. NO REFUNDS for missed classes.

REFUNDS for classes will be given ONLY in cases of accident or illness of a terrier or owner, or for bitches in season. Situations must be documented in writing. Refunds provided by mail within 14 days following the trial.

ALL entries the day of the trial, except when a terrier moves up in Go-to-Ground, will be considered Post Entries and will be charged the post entry fee. No additions or substitutions after a division have begun.

The Carolinas Jack Russell Terrier Club will again be using Trial Vault Trial-Management Services. Listed below are some details regarding this web-based program and what it will allow you to do as an exhibitor.

The creators of TrialVault have updated the program and released an all new TrialVault2 web-based trial management system. You might need to recreate you account for the new program, but you can now upload pictures of your dogs and your trial certificates!! You will be able to better control the details of your dogs in your account by adding a co-owner and checking all certificates your dog holds.

Accounts are free for attendees.

There is no cost to set up a TrialVault account and enter terrier profiles. Once terrier information is entered into TrialVault, it is stored in the cloud and can be used to register in any TrialVault hosted trial.

TrialVault stores terrier information in one place and tracks awards.

If you've entered a JRTCA-sanctioned terrier trial, you know about the detailed information you have to provide on all of your terriers—date of birth, registration numbers, certificates, proof of registration, and more. Using TrialVault, you only enter this information once, and then we store it in a central database. All those details are ready when you need them and registering for a new trial is as easy as a mouse click. TrialVault also keeps records of your terriers' trail winnings.

TrialVault is a web app that is continually improved and updated to the latest standards.

Unlike old-fashioned desktop programs on your PC, TrialVault is a web-based application that is accessed through web browsers like Chrome, Firefox, Safari, and Internet Explorer on desktop, laptops, and mobile devices. This means bugs can be fixed almost instantly and you always have the latest version.

You will be able to us either PayPal or you can print your confirmation page and mail it along with your check to Melissa Baggenstoss. HIGH POINT TERRIER
(NON-SANTIONED)

**Presented in Honor of
Laurel Gate Ladybug**



Bug's Bowl is an Antique Dry Measure Bowl, used in the 1800's to measure dry commodities. The red paint on the body is original. Jane Hughes' painting is featured.

This award will be given to the terrier (puppies are not eligible) earning the most TOTAL points in both trials. Only one (1) result from each division will be counted each day. Championship and Best Of classes do not count toward the dog's total points.

Qualifying Divisions will be Racing - Flats, Racing - Hurdles, Conformation, Go-to-Ground, Super Earth, Agility, Lure Coursing, Top Gun, Barn Hunt, Thunder Tunnel.

There will be a score sheet for each entered terrier included in the packets. Owners will be responsible for tracking and totaling their own dog's points and turning them in to the Trial Secretary when they have completed competition.

Points will be verified.

1st - 8 pts, 2nd - 6 pts, 3rd - 5 pts, 4th - 4 pts, 5th - 3 pts, 6th - 2 pts, Participation - 1 pt.

Ties will be broken by GTG times.

Terriers MUST be entered for High Point on Trial Vault or paper entry form.

Division A – Racing

Begins promptly at 8:30 am, NO POST ENTRIES!

*****Please Note:** To be eligible to run in the Championship race, the terrier **MUST** have entered and Finish in both the flat and steeplechase classes. A terrier that is not entered in both classes or has not finished in both classes is not eligible to run in the championship race. In this case, the second place terrier becomes eligible to run in the Championship race, assuming it was entered and ran and finished in both classes. All Racing Terriers including puppies must be muzzled. 4-6 Month old puppies will run flat races and return immediately for hurdles!!! .

- Class 2 Pups, 6 up to 9 months, up to 12 ½”
- Class 3 Pups, 6 up to 9 months, over 12 ½ up to 15”

- Class 6 Adult terriers, under 10 inches (*Non-sanctioned*)

- Class 8 Adults other than JRTCA Jack Russells that will fit through a 9” hole. (*Non-sanctioned*)
- Class 9 Senior Dogs, 9 years and older, 10” up to 12 ½”
- Class 10 Senior Dogs, 9 years and older, over 12 ½” up to 15”
- Class 11 Senior Bitches, 9 years and older, 10” up to 12 ½”
- Class 12 Senior Bitches, 9 years and older, over 12 ½” up to 15”
- Class 13 Dogs, 1 year and older, 10” up to 12 ½”
- Class 14 Dogs, 1 year and older, over 12 ½” up to 15”
- Class 15 Bitches, 1 year and older, 10” up to 12 ½”
- Class 16 Bitches, 1 year and older, over 12 ½” up to 15”
- Class 17 Veteran Dogs, 6 years and older, 10” up to 12 ½”
- Class 18 Veteran Dogs, 6 years and older, over 12 ½” up to 15”

- Class 31 Senior Bitches, 9 years and older, 10” up to 12 ½”
- Class 32 Senior Bitches, 9 years and older, over 12 ½” up to 15”
- Class 33 Puppy Championship, 10” up to 12 ½”. Open to 1st place winners of classes 2, 4, 22 and 24. No entry fee.
- Class 34 Puppy Championship, over 12 ½” up to 15”. Open to 1st place winners of classes 3,5,23 and 25. No entry fee.
- Class 35 Seniors Championship, 10” up to 12 ½”. Open to 1st place winners of classes 9, 11, 29 and 31. No entry fee.
- Class 36 Seniors Championship, over 12 ½” up to 15”. Open to 1st place winners of classes 10, 12, 30 and 32. No entry fee.

Adult Steeplechase Races over higher hurdles, over 8” up to 16”

- Class 37 Dogs, 1 year and older, 10” up to 12 ½”
- Class 38 Dogs, 1 year and older, over 12 ½” up to 15”
- Class 39 Bitches, 1 year and older, 10” up to 12 ½”
- Class 40 Bitches, 1 year and older, over 12 ½” up to 15”
- Class 41 Veteran Dogs, 6 years and older, 10” up to 12 ½”
- Class 42 Veteran Dogs, , 6 years and older, over 12 ½” up to 15
- Class 43 Veteran Bitches, 6 years and older, 10” up to 12 ½”
- Class 44 Veterans Bitches, 6 years and older, over 12 ½ up to 15”
- Class 45 Adult Championship, 10” up to 12 ½”. Open to 1st place winners of classes 13, 15, 37 and 39. No entry fee.
- Class 46 Adult Championship, over 12 ½” up to 15”. Open to 1st place winners of classes 14, 16, 38 and 40. No entry fee. (Winner receives the Winslow Pace Memorial trophy donated by Zeb & Pat Winslow – Saturday only)
- Class 47 Veteran Championship, 10” up to 12 ½”. Open to 1st place winners of classes 17, 19, 41 and 43. No entry fee.
- Class 48 Veteran Championship, Over 12 ½ up to 15”. Open to 1st place winners of classes 18, 20, 42 and 44. No entry fee.

Division B - Go-To-Ground

- Class 49 Open Adult Under 10" (Non-sanctioned):** Open to JR's one year of age and older under 10". Class will be run in the Open Tunnel. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before the quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.
- Class 50 Puppies other than Jack Russell's (Non-Sanctioned):** (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter until quarry is reached; mark quarry for 15 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry.) To be run in the Novice Tunnel.
- Class 51 Adults other than Jack Russell's (Non-Sanctioned):** (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another (examples baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.) To be run in the Open Tunnel.
- Class 52 Pre-Novice Puppy:** Open to Jack Russell puppies 4 up to 6 months. Entry in Pre-Novice Puppy class does not affect the puppy's eligibility to enter the Novice Class after 6 months of age. One minute to reach quarry; work quarry for 15 seconds; may leave earth and re-enter until quarry is reached.
- Class 53 Novice Puppy:** Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy Class at this trial. One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; when quarry is reached work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry.
- Class 54 Novice Adult:** Open to Jack Russells one year of age or older which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open class at this trial. One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; when quarry is reached work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry.
- Class 55 Open Puppy:** Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Not open to any puppies which have previously achieved 100% in this class. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship GTG class at this trial. 1 second per total feet of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.
- Class 56 Open Adult:** Open to Jack Russells one year or older which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. 1 second per total feet of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.
- Class 57 Puppy Championship:** Open to Jack Russells, 6 up to 12 months which have earned 100% in an Open Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of a 100% Open score sheet shall be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Puppy Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. 1 second per total feet of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter once before the quarry is reached; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. **(Winner receives the Foxplay Kennel trophy donated by Cindy O'Reily – Saturday only)**
- Class 58 10 up to 12½" Championship Certificate:** Open to any adult Jack Russell 10 up to 12½", one year and over, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. 1 second per total feet of tunnel; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. **(Winner receives the Highwater Burberry "Chatter" memorial trophy donated by Jim & Kris Tracy – Saturday only)**
- Class 59 Over 12½ up to 15" Championship Certificate:** Open to any adult Jack Russell over 12½ up to 15", one year and over, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. 1 second per total feet of tunnel; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.
- Class 60 10" up to 12½" Veteran Certificate:** Open to any adult Jack Russell 6 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. First and second place winners will be Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. **CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES.** 1 second per total feet of tunnel; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. **(Winner receives the Laurel Gate Clementine Memorial trophy donated by Pete Stubbs & Starr Bowen – Sunday only)**
- Class 61 Over 12½" up to 15" Veteran Certificate:** Open to any adult Jack Russell 6 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. First and second place winners will be Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. **CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES.** 1 second per total feet of tunnel; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. **(Trophy donated by Wild Rose Jack Russell Terriers – Sunday only)**
- Class 62 10" up to 12½" Senior Certificate:** Open to any adult Jack Russell 9 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. First and second place winners will be Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. **CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES.** 1 second per total feet of tunnel; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.
- Class 63 Over 12½" up to 15" Senior Certificate:** Open to any adult Jack Russell 9 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. First and second place winners will be Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. **CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES.** 1 second per total feet of tunnel; may not leave earth; work quarry for

one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. (Winner receives the Timber Ridge Ranger Memorial trophy donated by Jim & Kris Tracy – Saturday only)

Division F – Super Earth (Sanctioned)

A challenging GTG course with a series of false entrances and/or false tunnels and dens. Open to any Jack Russell Terrier, 6 months and older. 1 second per total feet of tunnel; may leave and re-enter earth several times until the quarry is reached; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Class 64 Puppies other than JRTCA Jack Russell's: (Non-sanctioned) Open to puppies 6- 12 month old that will fit through a 9 inch hole.

Class 65 Adults other than JRTCA Jack Russell's: (Non-sanctioned) Open to adults one year and older that will fit through a 9 inch hole.

Class 66 Open Puppy 6 – 12 month Super Earth: (Open to puppies which have not previously earned a 100% passing score in this class.)

Class 67 Open Adult 10" up to 12½" Super Earth: Open to terriers one year and older.

Class 68 Open Adult 12½ up to 15" Super Earth: Open to terriers one year and older.

Class 69 Open Veteran/Senior 10" up to 12½" Super Earth: Open to terriers six years and older.

Class 70 Open Veteran/Senior Over 12½ up to 15" Super Earth: Open to terriers six years and older.

Class 71 6 up to 12 Month Puppy Championship Super Earth. Open to 6 up to 12 month JRT puppies which have earned 100% in an Open 6 up to 12 Month Super Earth Puppy Class at this or a previous JRTCA Trial. A copy of a 100% score sheet must be presented with Pre-Entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Puppy Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 72 10" up to 12 ½" Adult Certificate Super Earth: Open to Jack Russell Terriers, one year and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and Second Place winners will be 10" up to 12 ½" Adult Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 73 Over 12 ½" up to 15" Adult Certificate Super Earth: Open to Jack Russell Terriers, one year and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and Second Place winners will be over 12 ½" -15" Adult Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 74 10" up to 12 ½" Veteran Certificate Super Earth: Open to Jack Russell Terriers, six years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and Second Place winners will be 10" up to 12 ½" Veteran Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 75 Over 12 ½" up to 15" Veteran Certificate Super Earth: Open to Jack Russell Terriers, six years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and Second Place winners will be Over 12 ½" up to 15" Veteran Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 76 10" up to 12 ½" Senior Certificate Super Earth: Open to Jack Russell Terriers, nine years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and Second Place winners will be 10" up to 12 ½" Senior Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 77 Over 12 ½" up to 15" Senior Certificate Super Earth: Open to Jack Russell Terriers, nine years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and Second Place winners will be Over 12 ½" up to 15" Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Section C- Youth

Terriers competing in Child or Youth GTG, if entered in regular GTG classes, must compete in the regular GTG class prior to competing in the Child or Youth GTG class. The same terrier must be handled in both the handler and go-to-ground classes.

Class 78 Child Handler: Open to any youth aged 5 through 9, handling a JRT 6 months of age or older. This class is offered as an introductory experience in handling and learning about the Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the child's ability to present his/her dog and beginning knowledge of the Jack Russell. Quality of the dog NOT to be considered. (*No entry fee if pre-entered*)

Class 79 Child Handler G-T-G: (non-sanctioned) Open to any child aged 5 through 9, handling a JRT 6 months of age or older. Judged on the child's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go-to-Ground. To be run through the 10 foot Novice liner; time not to be considered. Parent or adult help is permitted and encouraged for very young children (*No entry fee if pre-entered*)

Class 80 Child Handler High Score and Reserve: Awarded to the highest scoring child and runner –up in classes 78 and 79. Points are awarded as follow: 1st= 8 points, 2nd= 6 points; 3rd= 5 points, 4th= 4points, 5th= 3 points, 6th= 2 points and participation = 1 point. (non-sanctioned)

Class 81 Youth Handler: Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling a JRT 6 months or older. Judged on the youth's beginning knowledge of the Jack Russell and ability to present his/her dog. Quality of dog NOT to be considered. (No entry fee if pre entered)

Class 82 Youth G-T-G: Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling a JRT 6 months or older. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go-To-Ground. To be run through the 10 foot Novice liner; time not to be considered. (No entry fee if pre-entered)

Class 83 Youth Handler High Score & Reserve: Awarded to the highest scoring youth and runner-up in classes 81 and 82. The points are awarded as follows: 1st = 8 points; 2nd = 6 points; 3rd = 5 points; 4th = 4 points; 5th = 3 points, 6th = 2 points and participation = 1 point.

Division D - Conformation

Section 1: Family (Note: Stud Dog and Brood Bitch must be intact. Offspring may be intact, spayed or neutered.)

To qualify and use score sheet for exhibitor to apply for Jumpers/Game Certificate from the JRTCA requires three of either Jumpers/Games with no faults. May be mixed qualifying scores from both or each.

NOTE: The dogs with the two highest combined scores from classes 187, 190 & 191 will be the agility trial Champion and Reserve.

JRTCA General Rules For Exhibitors

1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
2. Exhibitors or owners of terriers entered must be current members of the JRTCA and not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRT's in any all-breed registry or conflicting organization. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entries will be disqualified and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
3. Entries MUST be within the 10-15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
4. Puppies (under 12 months of age) are not eligible for championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season to be refunded with vet certificate from owner, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairman.
6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family, Open or Working Conformation.
7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA judge may not be shown under that judge in the conformation division.
8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth handling classes. If an Affiliate sponsored trial is chaired by Committee, all on the Committee may enter their terriers in any phase of the competition.
9. Terriers owned by judges may not be entered in the division in which they are judging, but may enter the competition in any other division.
10. Terriers owned by stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in the same class number or by the Judge EXCEPT in Racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number; OR, if classes are split by gender, may call for the measurement of a terrier of the opposite gender in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of an under adult dog entered in Racing may call for the measurement of an under adult bitch as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races.) Exhibitors racing puppies may call for the measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. Only JRTCA height cards issued after September, 1999 will be honored.
12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation Ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive Use" will be at the judge's discretion.
13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier Classes or Certificate Go-To-Ground must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time post-entry. The judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the Ring/Den Steward at the time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC application signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered, and asked to leave the trial site.
15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off leash work. No liberty leashes allowed.
16. Overly aggressive dogs, or an owners' failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or Trial Chairperson.
17. The abuse or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site, and no entry fees will be refunded.
18. Dogs other than JRT's on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
19. Exhibitors are responsible to double check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be obtained by contacting the JRTCA office (410-561-3655) or it can be downloaded from the JRTCA web site (www.terrier.com).
21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their discretion.
22. All dogs brought to JRTCA sanctioned trials must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial who have suspicion of contagious or infectious disease.
23. **THE JUDGES' DECISIONS CONCERNING PLACEMENTS IS FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS.**
