The Carolinas Jack Russell Terrier Club would like to welcome Stephen Parkin to his first judging assignment of a JRTCA sanctioned trial in the US.

He was born in the small village of Hambleton in North Yorkshire, England. He grew up on a dairy farm with Jack Russell Terriers running around his feet- his mum bred and showed them. He was introduced to hunting at the age of 7. He was always in trouble at school for not doing his homework because he would come home from school, get changed and take about 15 Russells out and go hunting for whatever he could find on his father's land. Starting at the age of 18, he started whipping-in at the Bramham Moor Hunt. He held this position for about 10 seasons but missed the terrier work. He got the chance to become the terrierman for the York and Ainsty South Hunt. He held this position for over 20 seasons then moved on to the Grove and Rufford Hunt. He is in his second season with them. He accompanied his mother to terrier shows and excelled as a child handler then moved onto showing as an adult. He has won many top shows and has judged many prestigious shows in Wales, Canada, Germany, Sweeden and Denmark. He and his wife, Kath, help organize and run the Great Yorkshire show every year. He currently has 23 Jack Russell Terriers. He breeds a couple of litters a year to try and improve his stock. He only uses good proven working dogs.

Showing, judging and working his terrier is what his life is all about and what he lives for.



Stewards and club volunteers will have a FAST PASS to move to the front of the line to run all of their dogs

All puppies must be current on their vaccinations and no puppies under 3 months of age will be allowed at the trial or in RVs. No Exceptions. No puppy sales at trial site. If you have young puppies, please bring a Stud Certificate to verify age. This will be strictly enforced. You will be asked to leave and no refunds will be given.

There will be no food service available at the park. There are many fast food restaurants nearby.

All Performance Events, including Go-To-Ground, Super Earth, Barn Hunt, Lure Coursing, Fast Terrier and Thunder Tunnel... Due to excessive waits for people with one terrier participating in events, we are implementing a new procedure. If you choose to bring all of your terriers at one time, you may run one terrier and, while you are getting your next terrier ready to go, you must let the next person in line run theirs.

Shorty Performance

Scores from racing flats, racing hurdles and go-to-ground will be added together. 1st - 5 points, 2nd - 3 points, 3rd - 2 points and 4th - 1 point. Go little guys and girls!

Every effort will be made to start trial events on time. Dogs late to racing or conformation will be scratched. NO REFUNDS for missed classes.

REFUNDS for classes will be given ONLY in cases of accident or illness of a terrier or owner, or for bitches in season. Situations must be documented in writing. Refunds provided by mail within 14 days following the trial.

ALL entries the day of the trial, except when a terrier moves up in Go-to-Ground, will be considered Post Entries and will be charged the post entry fee. No additions or substitutions after a division has begun.

A copy of your 2024 JRTCA Membership certificate and copies of Certificates in Championship GTG, Super Earth, and Working terriers must be submitted with your entries, emailed before the trial or presented to the Trial Secretary at the Registration table.

Ringside spaces will be assigned according to request, if possible. NO one is allowed to change ringside without permission of trial chair. All parties must agree to the change.

BUG'S BOWL
HIGH POINT TERRIER
(NON-SANCTIONED)

**Presented in Honor of
Laurel Gate Ladybug**



Bug's Bowl is an Antique Dry Measure Bowl, used in the 1800's to measure dry commodities. The red paint on the body is original. Jane Hughes' painting is featured.

This award will be given to the terrier (puppies are not eligible) earning the most TOTAL points in both trials. Only one (1) result from each division will be counted each day. Championship and Best Of classes do not count toward the dog's total points.

Qualifying Divisions will be Racing - Flats, Racing - Hurdles, Conformation, Go-to-Ground, Super Earth, Agility, Lure Coursing, Fast Terrier, Barn Hunt, Thunder Tunnel.

There will be a score sheet for each entered terrier included in your packet. Owners will be responsible for tracking and totaling their own dog's points and turning them in to the Trial Secretary when they have completed competition.

Points will be verified.

1st - 8 pts, 2nd - 6 pts, 3rd - 5 pts, 4th - 4 pts, 5th - 3 pts, 6th - 2 pts, Participation - 1 pt.

Ties will be broken by GTG times.

Terriers MUST be entered for High Point in Trial Vault or on paper entry form.

Division A – Racing No post entries in racing, except to fill heats.

Racing begins promptly at 8:30 am.

All terriers must be muzzled! Plastic muzzles or close-ended cloth muzzles only. Black, brown, clear, or white muzzles are acceptable; no colored basket or softie muzzles are allowed. NO figure eight, open-ended or Baskerville muzzles will be allowed.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR CHAMPIONSHIP RUN OFFS:

- A. Terrier must place first in a flat or hurdle race final to qualify for championship run offs. First to the hole is not necessarily first through the backside of the barrier. (01/22)
- B. A terrier MUST ENTER AND FINISH in both, at least one flat race AND one hurdle race at the beginning level based on trial entries (heat, semi, final).
- C. A terrier must continue to advance, if qualified, to all additional semi-final heats up to the final championship race. If injured, the terrier is then finished and cannot race in the final.
- D. A FINISHED race is when the terrier runs down the track unassisted (by owner or anyone else) with a secured muzzle to the backside of the barrier.
- E. In the event a terrier does not meet all the above criteria, the second place terrier in the final of that class (either flats or hurdles) will qualify for the championship run off if they meet the criteria as outlined above. (01/20)

Class 46 Over 12 ½" up to 15" Adult Racing Championship, Open to 1st place winners of classes 15, 17, 38 and 40. No entry fee.
(Winner receives the Winslow Pace Memorial trophy donated by Zeb & Pat Winslow – Saturday only)
Class 47 10" up to 12 ½" Veteran Racing Championship, Open to 1st place winners of classes 18, 20, 41 and 43. No entry fee.
Class 48 Over 12 ½" up to 15" Veteran Racing Championship, Open to 1st place winners of classes 19, 21, 42 and 44. No entry fee.

Division B - Go-To-Ground

A timed event that simulates the terrier's natural instinct to hunt. The terrier enters an artificial den/tunnel to demonstrate its working ability. Schooling prior to the competition is not permitted. Terrier may switch from one type of work to another (examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.) For Championship Certificate classes, a copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. No cross entering between Certificate classes.

Timing is as follows:

Novice Puppy & Novice Adult - One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry for 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Open Puppy & Open Adult - One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter once until quarry is reached; must work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Puppy Championship - One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter once until quarry is reached; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Championship Certificate Classes - One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave the earth; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Class 49 Under 10" Adult Terrier Go-To-Ground (Non-Sanctioned): Open to JR's one year of age and older under 10". 30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before the quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. To be run in the Open Tunnel.

Class 50 Puppies other than Jack Russells Go-To-Ground (Non-Sanctioned): One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter until quarry is reached; mark quarry for 15 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry. To be run in the Novice Tunnel.

Class 51 Adults other than Jack Russells Go-To-Ground (Non-Sanctioned): One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry. To be run in the Open Tunnel.

Class 52 Pre-Novice Puppy Go-To-Ground: Open to Jack Russell puppies 4 up to 6 months. Entry in Pre-Novice Puppy class does not affect the puppy's eligibility to enter the Novice Class after 6 months of age. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter until quarry is reached; work quarry for 15 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)

Class 53 Novice Puppy Go-To-Ground: Open to Jack Russell puppies 6 up to 12 months which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy Class at this trial.

Class 54 Novice Adult Go-To-Ground: Open to Jack Russells one year of age or older which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open class at this trial.

Class 55 Open Puppy Go-To-Ground: Open to Jack Russell puppies 6 up to 12 months which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship GTG class at this trial **OR** may continue competing in Open Puppy Go-to-Ground class at future trials. Open Puppy GTG is not open to any Puppy which has competed in Puppy Championship GTG.

Class 56 Open Adult Go-To-Ground: Open to Jack Russell Terriers, one year or older, registered or non-registered, which have previously scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Terriers may continue to compete in the Open Adult Class until they receive their Trial Certificate. Terriers, one year or older, registered or non-registered, which have previously scored 100% in the Open Adult Class, are eligible to apply for a Trial Certificate when the terrier is registered or recorded with the JRTCA.

Class 57 Puppy Championship Go-To-Ground: Open to Jack Russell puppies, 6 up to 12 months, which have earned 100% in an Open Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of a 100% Open score sheet shall be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Puppy Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve.

Class 58 10" up to 12½" Adult Championship Certificate Go-To-Ground: Open to any adult Jack Russell, 10" up to 12½", one year and over, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve.

Class 59 Over 12½" up to 15" Adult Championship Certificate Go-To-Ground: Open to any adult Jack Russell, over 12½" up to 15", one year and over, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve.

Class 60 10" up to 12½" Veteran Championship Certificate Go-To-Ground: Open to any adult Jack Russell, 10" up to 12½", 6 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate.

(Winner receives the Laurel Gate Clementine Memorial trophy donated by Pete Stubbs & Starr Bowen – Sunday only)

Class 61 Over 12½" up to 15" Veteran Championship Certificate Go-To-Ground: Open to any adult Jack Russell, over 12½" up to 15", 6 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate.

Class 62 10" up to 12 ½" Senior Championship Certificate Go-To-Ground: Open to any adult Jack Russell, 10" up to 12½", 9 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate.

Class 63 Over 12 ½" up to 15" Senior Championship Certificate Go-To-Ground: Open to any adult Jack Russell, over 12½" up to 15", 9 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate.

Division C – Super Earth

A challenging GTG course with a series of false entrances and/or false tunnels and dens. Open to any Jack Russell Terrier, 6 months and older. Schooling prior to the competition is not permitted. Terrier may switch from one type of work to another (examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.) For Championship Certificate classes, a copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. No cross entering between Certificate classes.

Timing for all Super Earth classes: One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave and re-enter the earth multiple times until quarry is reached; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. Terrier is not to leave quarry once it is reached.

Class 64 Puppies other than JRTCA Jack Russells: (Non-Sanctioned) Open to puppies 6-12 month old that will fit through a 9 inch hole.

Class 65 Adults other than JRTCA Jack Russells: (Non-Sanctioned) Open to adults one year and older that will fit through a 9 inch hole.

Class 66 6 up to 12 month Open Puppy Super Earth: Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship Super Earth class at this trial OR may continue competing in Open Puppy Super Earth class at future trials. Open Puppy Super Earth is not open to any Puppy which has competed in Puppy Championship Super Earth.

Class 67 10" up to 12½" Open Adult Super Earth: Open to Jack Russell Terriers one year and older.

Class 68 Over 12½" up to 15" Open Adult Super Earth: Open to Jack Russell Terriers one year and older.

Class 69 10" up to 12½" Open Veteran/Senior Super Earth: Open to Jack Russell Terriers six years and older.

Class 70 Over 12½" up to 15" Open Veteran/Senior Super Earth: Open to Jack Russell Terriers six years and older.

Class 71 6 up to 12 Month Puppy Championship Super Earth. Open to 6 up to 12 month Jack Russell Terrier puppies which have earned 100% in a 6 up to 12 month Open Puppy Super Earth Class at this or a previous JRTCA Trial. A copy of a 100% score sheet must be presented with pre-entry or be shown to den steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Puppy Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 72 10" up to 12½" Adult Championship Certificate Super Earth: Open to Jack Russell Terriers, 10" up to 12½", one year and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and Second Place winners will be Under Adult Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 73 Over 12½" up to 15" Adult Championship Certificate Super Earth: Open to Jack Russell Terriers, over 12½" up to 15", one year and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and Second Place winners will be Over Adult Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

- Class 74 10" up to 12½" Veteran Championship Certificate Super Earth:** Open to Jack Russell Terriers, 10" up to 12½", six years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. JRTCA General Rules For Exhibitors

1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members and not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT registry. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
3. Entries MUST be within the 10-15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
4. Puppies (under 12 months) are not eligible for a championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season will be refunded with a veterinarian certificate, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.
6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family*, Open or Working Conformation. *Note: For Family Classes, Brood Bitches and Stud Dogs entered may not be spayed/neutered. The offspring at their sides may be intact or spayed/neutered.
7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the conformation division.
8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth Handling.
9. Terriers owned by judges may not be entered in the division or section in which they are judging but may enter the competition in any other division. (Exception - Ring 2 Nationals judge may have terriers shown in Ring 1)
10. Terriers owned by stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number or by the Judge EXCEPT in Racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number; OR, if classes are split by gender, may call for the measurement of a terrier of the opposite gender in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of an under adult dog entered in Racing may call for the measurement of an under adult bitch as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races.) Exhibitors racing puppies may call for the measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. Only JRTCA height cards issued after September 1999 will be honored.
12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at Judge's discretion.
13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier classes, or Certificate Go-To-Ground and Super Earth must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post-entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the Ring/Den steward at time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC application signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered and asked to leave the trial site. (This applies to RVs and Campers, if at the same address as the trial grounds).(01/22)
15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off-leash work. No liberty leashes allowed.
16. Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the Trial Chairperson.
17. The abuse or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site, and no entry fees will be refunded.
18. Dogs other than JRTs on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
19. Exhibitors are responsible to double check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be downloaded from the JRTCA website (www.therealjackrussell.com).
21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their discretion.
22. All dogs brought to the trial must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial who have suspicion of contagious or infectious disease.
23. Judges may not eat, smoke, vape, or use cell phones while judging their event. (01/22)
24. THE JUDGES' DECISIONS ARE FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS.
